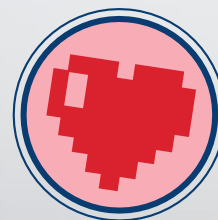

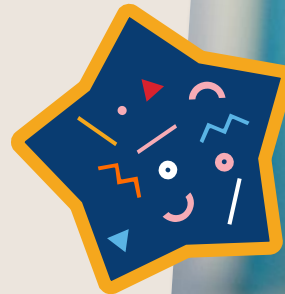

STEM Night

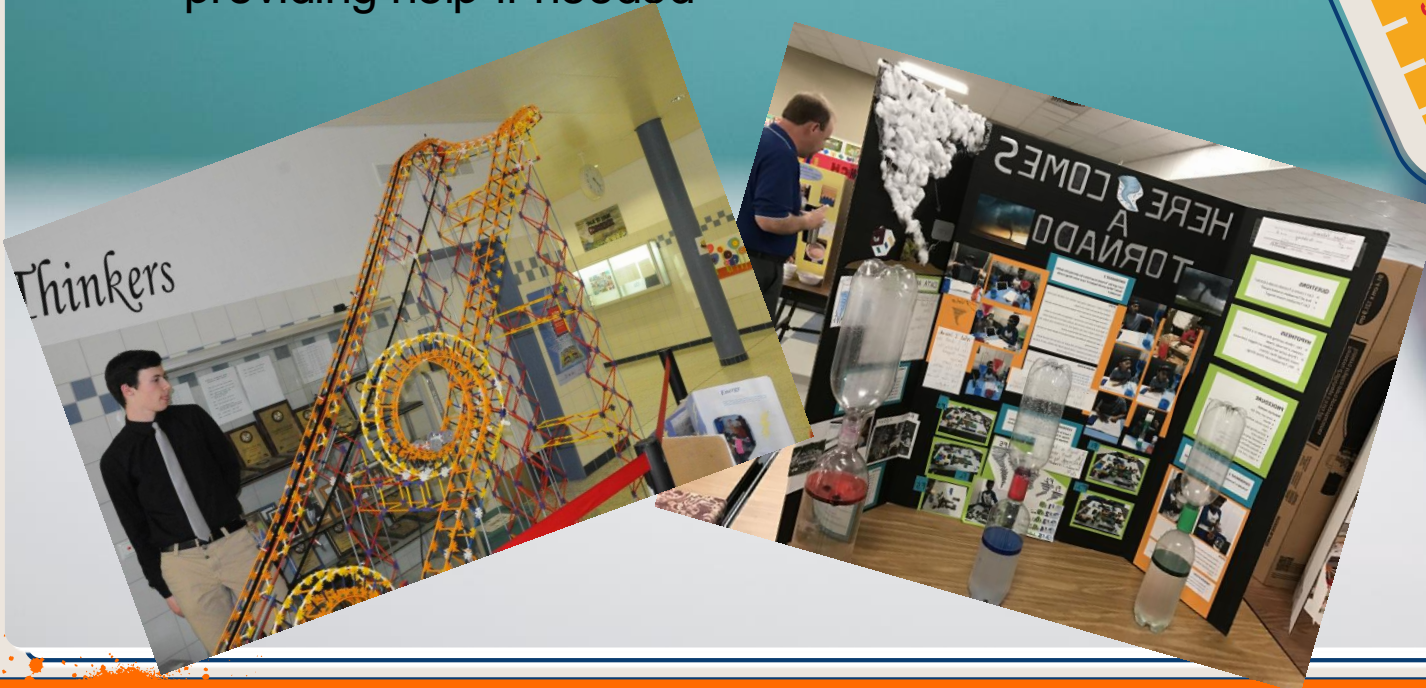
- Teachers will pick Top Two/One project(s) per period to show case.

- STEM Night: November 7th, January 16th and March 19th from 6pm to 8pm





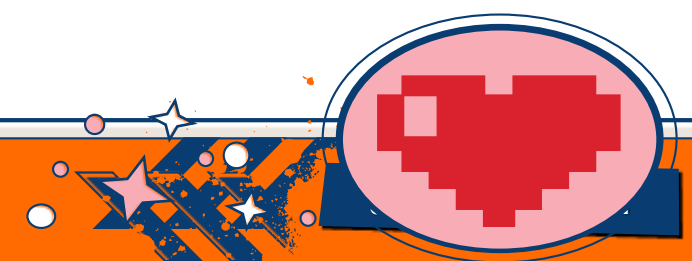
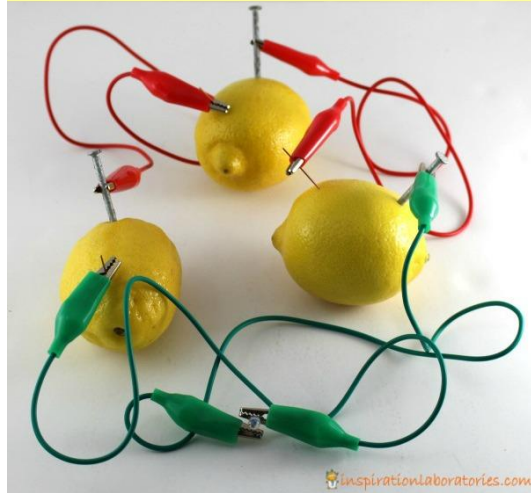
House Keeping

- STEM Ambassadors: will be walking around providing help if needed

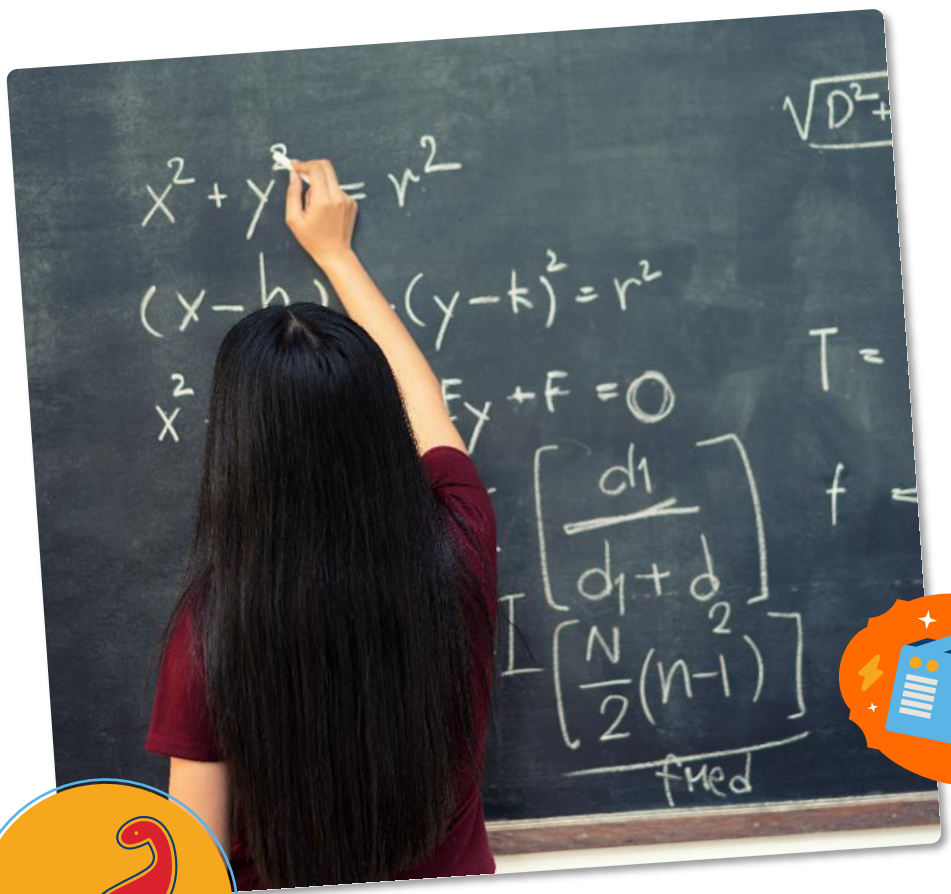
